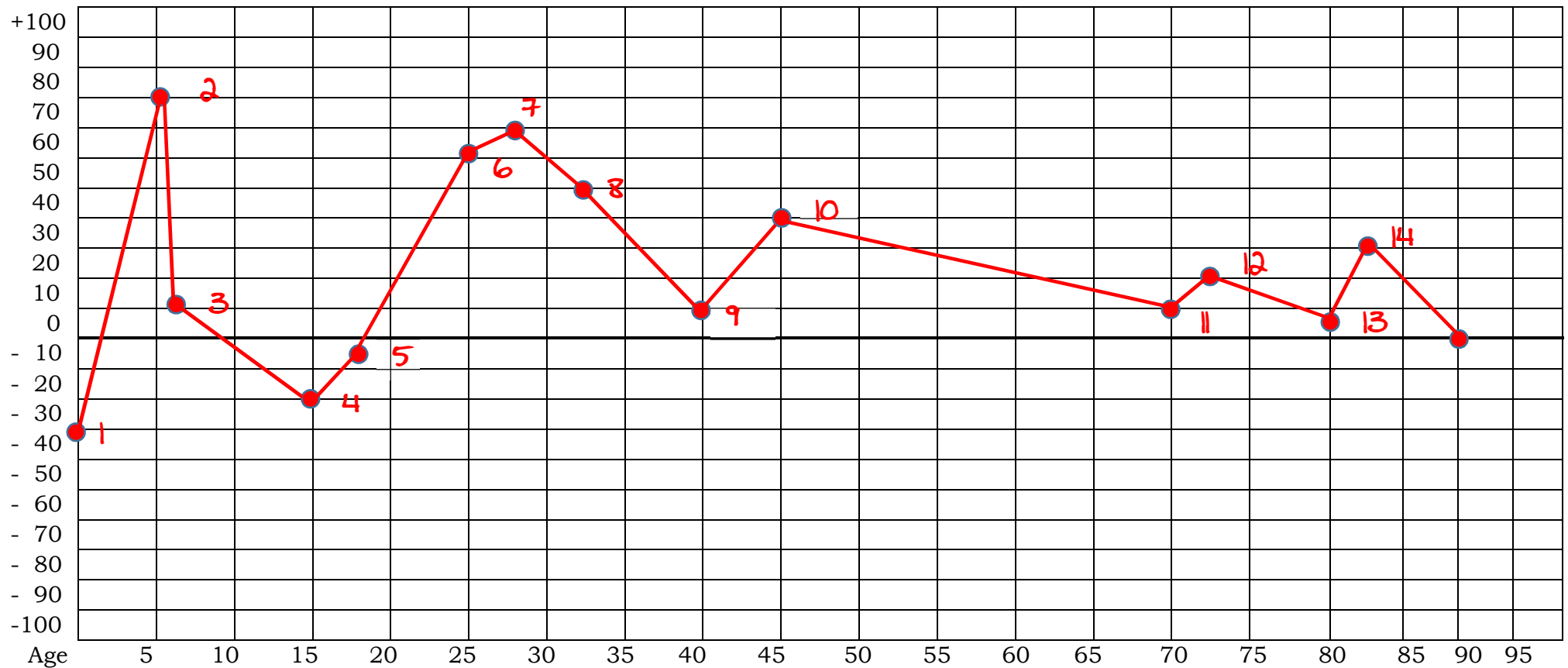


YOUR LIFE GRAPH (EXAMPLE GRAPH)
